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As readers and authors, we are reading Firework-Makers Daughter by Phillip Pullman and we will be using this text to help us write a range of different texts. After half term, we will be looking at The Story of Tutankhamun.

As mathematicians, we will be learning about multiplication and division and finding patterns within the times tables, before moving on to learn about the formal method of multiplication and division. After half term, we will be focusing on length, perimeter and area of shapes.

As creative artists, we will be looking at still life drawings and focusing on different artists techniques to help influence our own creations.

As scientific enquirers, we will be exploring different states of matter and the properties they have. We will be planning and carrying out lots of different experiments to help us understand more about the different states of matter.

As historians, we will be focusing on Ancient Egypt, looking at key events and figures that took place throughout Ancient Egypt.

As geographers, we will be learning all about our local area and what makes our local area special to us. We will be focusing on both physical and human geographical features, whilst also seeing how our local area has changed over time.

As users of technology, we will be learning all about creating a website and how we can affectively communicate information in an efficient and esthetical pleasing layout.

In French, we will be studying the basic greetings in French and how to count to 10. Next term, we will be looking at musical instruments.

As theologians and philosophers, we will be exploring what type of world Jesus wanted and why Christians might have believed this. After half term, we will be thinking about 'How might your Worldview lead you to do hard things for good reasons?'

As practical problem solvers, we will be looking at different mechanical systems and creating our own pneumatic toy.

For our health and well-being, we will be looking at Health and Wellbeing and how we can best support ourselves by being healthy. After half term, we will be looking at, how we keep ourselves safe and the growing and changing of our bodies.

In P.E, we will be looking at invasion games and focusing on hockey. This will be looking at team work, hand eye co-ordination and a range of different ball and stick skills. Next half term we will be focusing on football.

As musicians, we are focusing on STOP to help us build our musical skills and start to develop our ability to improvise. After half term we will looking at The Nutcracker – Waltz of the Flowers and Russian Dance – Tchaikovsky.
